M.Sc. in Psychiatric (Mental Health) Nursing Entrance Examination AY 2026

(Batch: 2026-2028)

1. Admit card will be sent through email to all the eligible candidates
2. Download the admit card, print it and paste same photograph which was submitted along with application form and bring it at the time of examination along with photocopy of I'd Card. Admit card will be verified by University of Delhi at the time of entrance examination.
3. **Venue for entrance examination:** The center of the Examination will be **Maharishi Kanad Bhawan, University of Delhi, North Campus, Near Gate No.1, Delhi-110007. The Candidate Needs to make entry from Gate No. 1 of the University of Delhi. The nearest Metro Station is Vishwavidyalaya Metro Station. Parking facility is not available in the examinations center.**
4. **Examination will commence at 9.30am on 5th July 2026 (SUNDAY)**
5. Reporting time of Candidate will be 09:00 AM. Gate Closing Timing will be 09:15 AM.
6. Timing of Examination will be 9:30 AM to 11:00 AM. No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination hall after 9.15am
7. Candidates must bring a valid photo ID proof in original (PAN card, Driving License, Voter ID, Passport, Aadhaar Card). The name on the photo ID must match the name as shown on the Admit Card at the time of examination.
8. Candidates must reach the Centre at the time mentioned against reporting time at the Centre in the Admit Card.
9. No electronic devices, calculators, or written/printed material are allowed in the exam hall. No arrangements will be made at the centers for keeping candidates' belongings/Mobile Phones.
10. Candidates are advised to visit the Examination Centre a day in advance to locate the venue to avoid any inconvenience.
11. Candidates must bring the following: Admit Card, a simple transparent blue and black ball Point Pen, additional photograph (same as uploaded on the Application Form)
12. Candidates will not leave the exam room before the exam ends.
13. Impersonation or malpractice will lead to disqualification.

23. The University of Delhi's decision on the challenges shall be final and no further communication will be entertained. University of Delhi will not inform the candidates individually about the outcome of the challenges made.
24. The subject experts will examine all the challenges received and then a final answer key will be displayed and declared.
25. The result will be compiled based on the final answer key declared. No grievance with regard to answer key(s) after the declaration of result will be entertained.
26. The candidate can obtain OMR response sheet by paying non-refundable online payment of Rs. 1000/- within a week from the last date of exam.
27. The life of answer sheet is 30 days from the date of examination.
